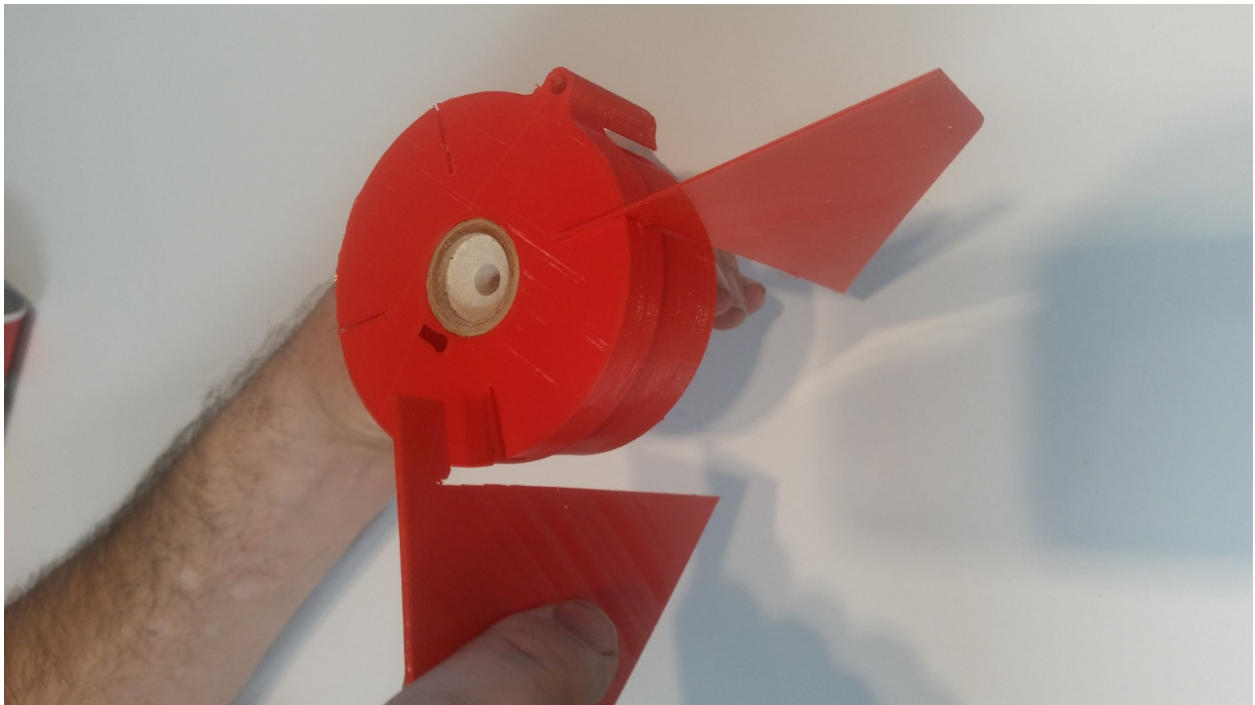




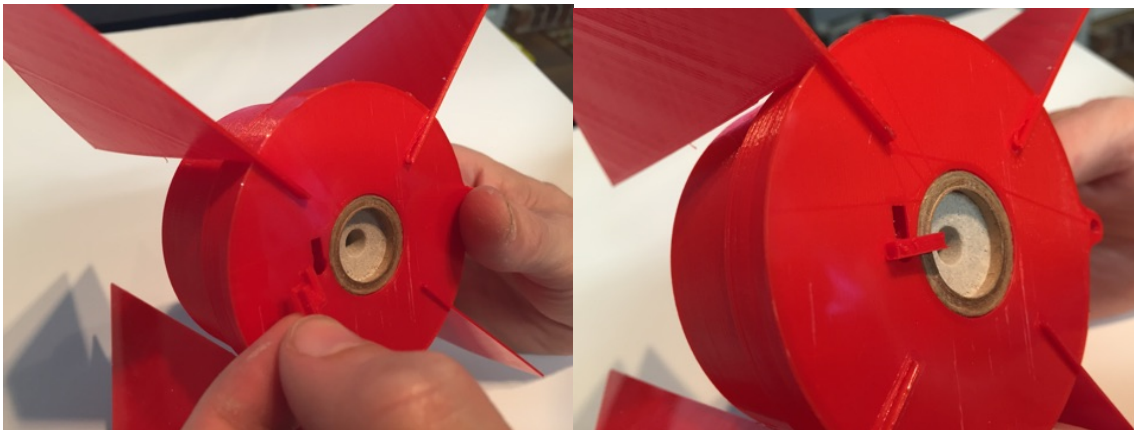
REDNECK ROCKET

STEP 1



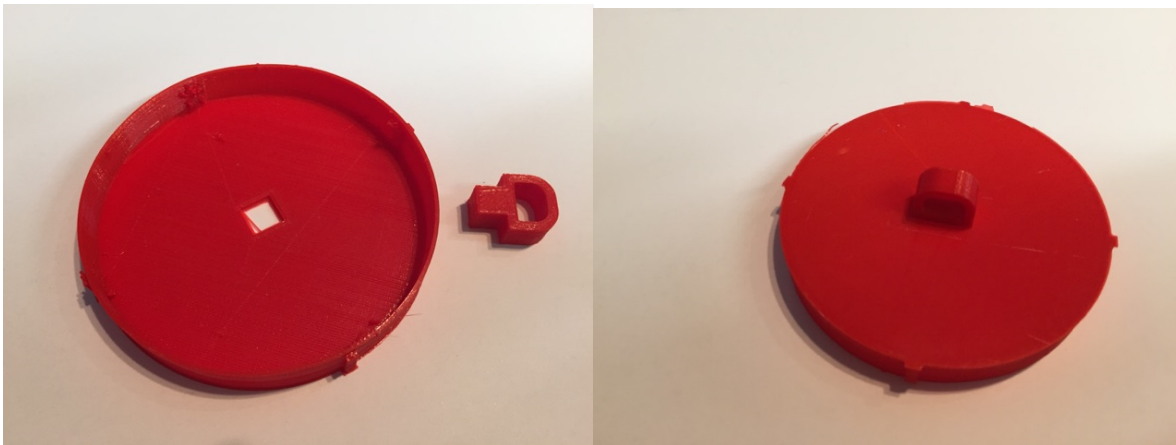
INSERT FINS (RECON YOU COULD ADD THE FINS LATER)

STEP 3



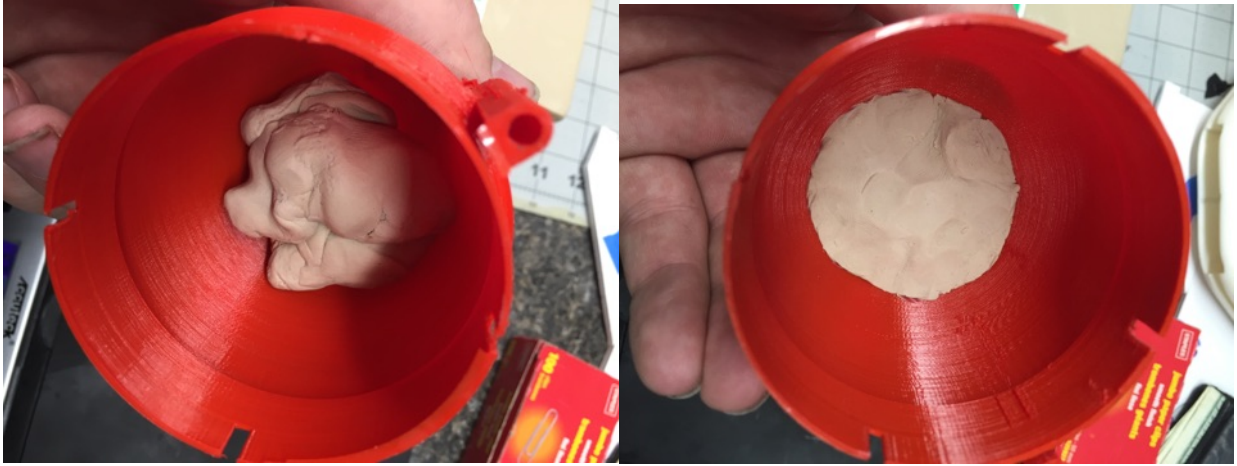
GLUE THIS HERE PART TO THE DISK LOOKING THING

STEP 5



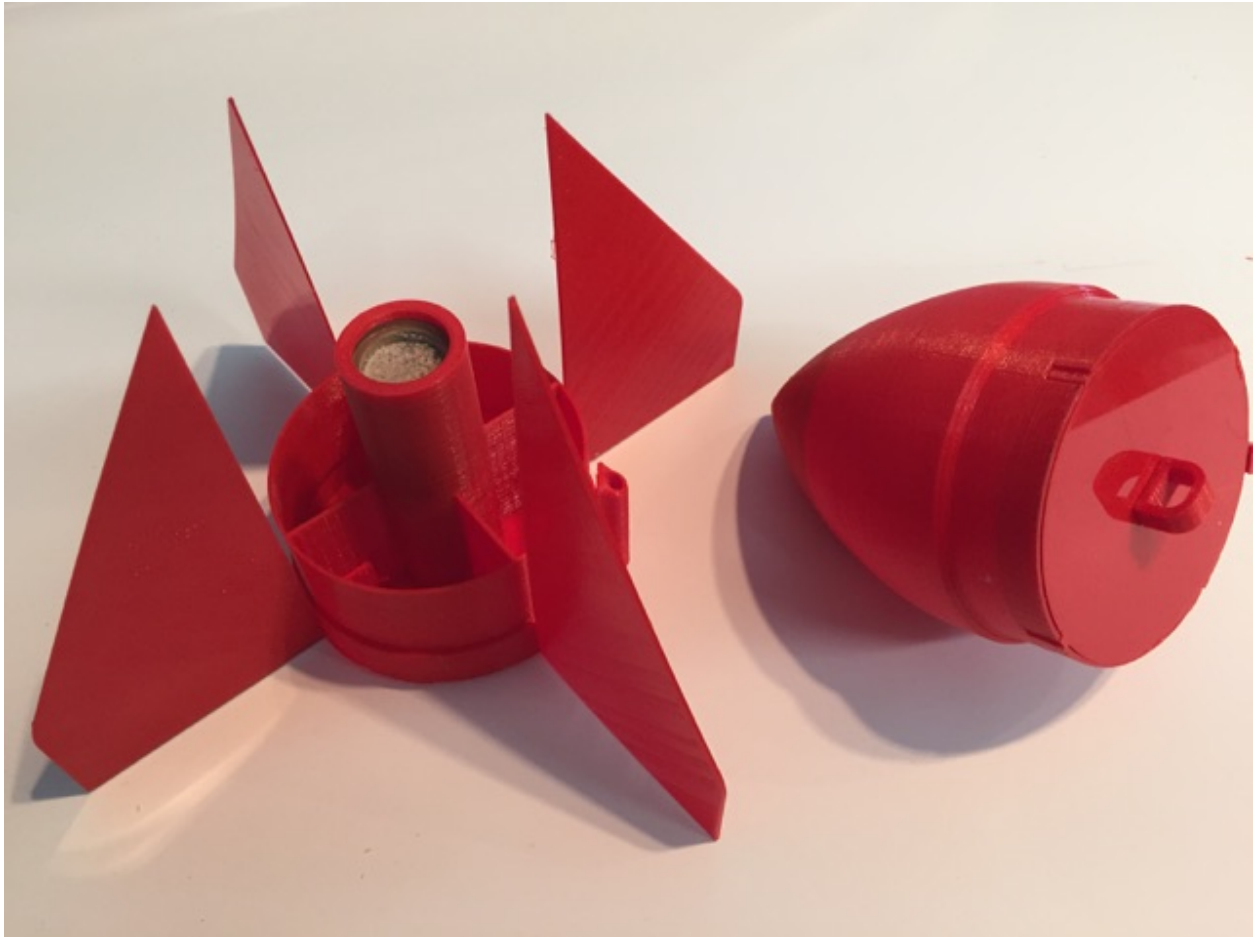
MASH THAT STUFF GOOD AND TIGHT INTO THE POINTED PART

STEP 6



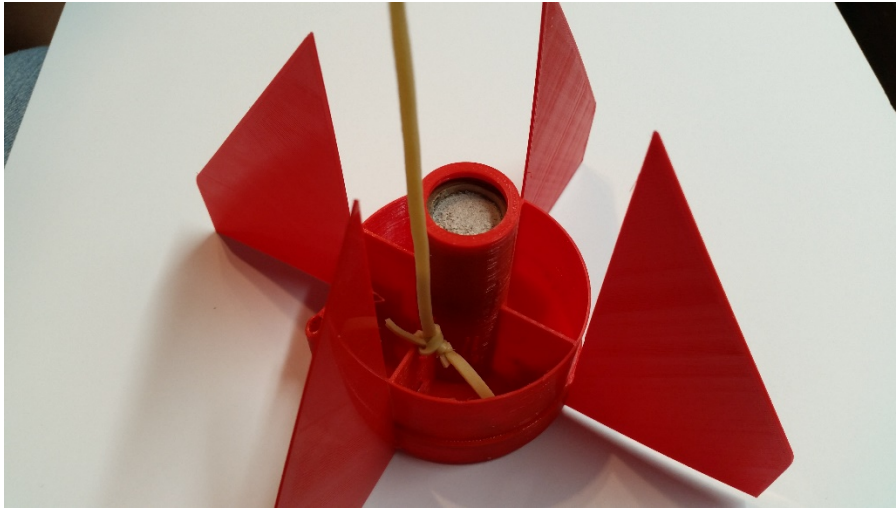
GLUE THIS UP

STEP 8



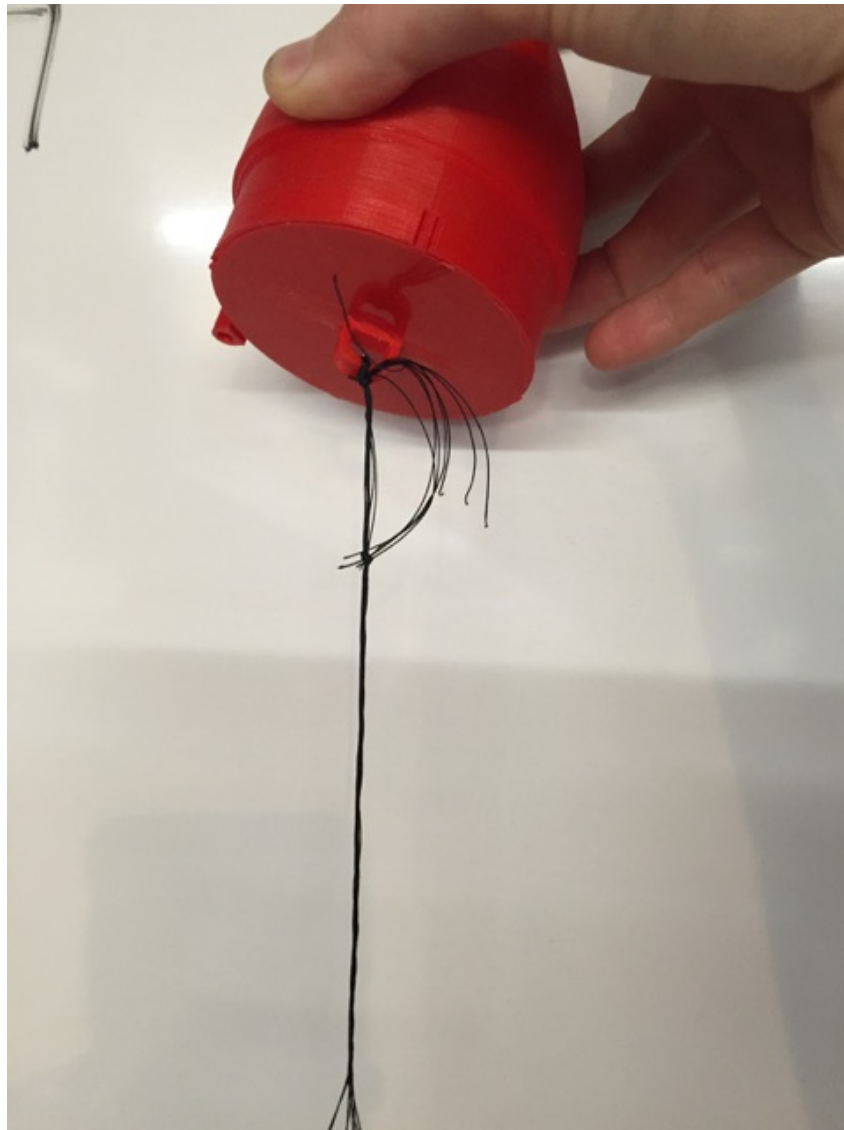
TIE A STRING OR RUBBER BAND TO THE HOLE HERE
