



REDNECK ROCKET




INSERT FINS (RECON YOU COULD ADD THE FINS LATER)

WEIGH OUT 2.8 OUNCES OF CLAY




MASH THAT STUFF GOOD AND TIGHT INTO THE POINTED PART

IF YOUR PARTS DON'T LOOK LIKE THIS, INFORM HOUSTON YOU HAVE A PROBLEM




TIE A STRING OR RUBBER BAND TO THE HOLE HERE





SLIDE TAIL SECTION ON TO BOTTOM OF PRINGLES CAN (USE GLUE IF YOU EVER WANT TO SEE ROCKET AGAIN)



TIE PARACHUTE TO CONE. IF YOU NEED HELP MAKING A
PARACHUTE, LOCATE THE NEAREST 10 YEAR OLD FOR
ASSISTANCE



GRAB A ROD AND SLIDE THROUGH STAND. ANY ROD WILL WORK AS LONG AS IT'S STRAIGHT AND WON'T BEND EASILY.



SLIDE THE ROD DOWN IN THE GROUND, POINTING SLIGHTLY TOWARDS WIND
